In the event of an emergency at the McGuire Nuclear Power Station, Pine Lake Preparatory will implement a response plan in coordination with Iredell County Emergency Management officials to ensure the safety and welfare of our students and school community. We are required to keep Potassium Iodide (KI) tablets at the school in case there is a radiation accident at the station. We need your permission to administer the Potassium Iodide. Please complete the form below and return it to the LS, MS, or US Administrative Associates.

Potassium Iodide (KI), if taken within the appropriate time period and in the appropriate dosage, will block the thyroid gland's uptake of radioactive iodine and reduces the risk of thyroid cancer. Scientific studies have demonstrated that young children have the highest risk of health effects. Therefore, this written permission will allow us to administer the tablets to your child, if directed to do so by local emergency management officials.
