Steps to Follow for Dual Enrollment Registration



Dual Enrollment at Pine Lake Preparatory

- Students may take select college courses through nearby community colleges that could satisfy high school graduation requirements and/or potentially transfer into colleges.
 - Most students take courses through Central Piedmont Community College & Mitchell Community College. However, students are not limited to these schools.
- For colleges outside the UNC system, it is up to the discretion of that college/university as to how and if the credits will transfer.
- The program is available to 11th & 12th grade students.
- Terms are available for Fall/Spring/Summer*

*Summer is available to rising 12th grade student only

Eligibility Requirements

- Weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Meet college readiness scores (determined via standardized test scores or community college placement exam NC DAP/Accuplacer)
- See MCC or CPCC web sites for NC DAP and Accuplacer scores
- Fulfill all prerequisites for the course

Application & Registration Procedure

- Notify Mrs. Dworsky of your interest in the program
- Complete the college specific dual enrollment application and submit to Mrs. Dworsky
 - Mitchell Community College's preferred application deadline is **February 28:**

Application & Registration Procedure

- Mrs. Dworsky will submit the supplemental transcript and test scores along with your application
- If you have not met the minimum scores for entry you need to coordinate your NC DAP or Accuplacer testing through the community college
- Once approved through the community college you will be notified of your next steps (Ex- completing an online orientation, setting up an community college email, etc)

Application & Registration Procedures

- Students are responsible to registering into the courses once accepted into the program
- Students should consult Mrs. Dworsky or Mrs. Honore regarding course selections
- Central Piedmont's registration window opens online for both Summer & Fall courses on May 1
- Mitchell's registration window online opens for both Summer & Fall on April 3
